Nick Schwartz is a landscape architect working for Drew Maristch who own a 70-acre parcel located at 0 Neddo Street. The owners would like to subdivide this property and develop a net zero energy development. There is a capacity of usable land to create up to 14 lots ranging in size from 3-1/2 – 9 acres each with a private roadway into the properties. Mr. Schwartz asked if water and sewer would be available for this development. He stated that there would be no clear cutting of the area. Mayor Eagan stated that the sub-division would go through the Planning Board and that the Village would have to check to verify if the sewer system could take on more connections.

William Dydo operates a business at 62 Main Street and is here to discuss the things that he has placed on the sidewalk and has been asked to remove them. Compliance Officer Dan Styczynski stated that as long as Mr. Dydo removes the items so people can walk comfortably along this sidewalk without being encumbered. He has asked Mr. Dydo to only place items on one side of the sidewalk. Mr. Dydo wants to be able to allow people to enjoy the outdoors and will work with the Compliance Officer to rectify the situation.

Dana Grant thinks that the No Parking on Main Street needs to be reconsidered. There are no parking spots available and he was promised a curb cut into his property and this has not been completed by the Village yet.

Gary Hill has an issue with unauthorized people shooting off fireworks. He doesn't feel that this should be allowed in the Village. Sgt. Davidsen will provide extra patrols in this area.

Roark Merrill would like to have outside seating for Historic Grounds on Main Street. He will have an architect create a drawing of his idea to present to the Board. He also has an issue with trucks constantly using Jake brakes and the noise this creates. Mayor Eagan stated that the signs that were placed at the entrances to the Village regarding the law to disallow the use of Jake brakes have been stolen twice.

Motion made by Trustee LaChapelle, seconded by Trustee Putorti to approve the minutes of the June 21st meeting, all voting in favor, CARRIED

LETTERS: NYS Division of Budget sent correspondence regarding the final payment of the American Rescue Plan Act Local Fiscal Recovery Funds will be paid this summer in the amount of \$130,358.57. Motion made by Trustee Norton, seconded by Trustee Watson to accept and file the correspondence, all voting in favor, CARRIED

BILLS: Motion made by Trustee Norton, seconded by Trustee Watson to approve payment of the abstract covering claims #23-00077 and 23-00085-23-00121 totaling \$69,945.52, all voting in favor, CARRIED

REPORTS: Compliance and Zoning Officer submitted a report for June. Motion made by Trustee LaChapelle, seconded by Trustee Putorti to accept the report and to place it on file, all voting in favor, CARRIED

Motion made by Trustee Norton, seconded by Trustee Watson to approve the attached resolution authorizing the Mayor or Village designated representative to submit the application the NYS Dept. of Environmental Conservation Water Quality Improvement Project program funds through the CFA process and to act in connection with the submission of the application, all voting in favor, CARRIED

Trustee Watson reported that the Dept. of Public Works have repaired water leaks, fixed potholes and installed a 12" valve. Mayor Eagan asked when the blocks would be removed on North Williams Street. Trustee Watson stated that the railing will be repaired once the pipe is received.
