LOCAL LAW NUMBER 2 OF 2014

BE IT ENACTED BY THE TOWN BOARD AS FOLLOWS:

**A Local Law Amending Local Law # 4 of 2006 Providing for Tax Exemptions for
Senior Citizens who are sixty-five years of age or over Pursuant to Real Property
Tax Law 467**

BE IT ENACTED, by the Town Board of the TOWN OF WHITEHALL, in the County of Washington, State of New York as follows:

Section 1. Local Law # 4 of 2006 is hereby amended as follows: Pursuant to the provisions of Section 467 of the Real Property Tax Law of the State of New York with regard to amending its sliding scale provision for real property exemptions for persons who are sixty-five years of age or over pursuant to the following schedule:

<u>Annual Income</u>	<u>Percentage Assessment Valuation Exempt From Taxation</u>
Up to 24,000	50%
24,000.01-24,999.99	45%
25,000. – 25,999.99	40%
26,000. – 26,999.99	35%
27,000. – 27,899.99	30%
27,900. – 28,799.99	25%
28,800. - 29,699.99	20%
29,700. – 30,599.99	15%
30,600. – 31,499.99	10%
31,500. – 32,399.99	5%

Section 2. This Local Law shall supersede Local Law # 4 of 2006 which is hereby repealed.

Section 3. This Local Law shall take effect upon filing with the Secretary of State of the State of New York.

LOCAL LAW NUMBER 3 OF 2014

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE TOWN BOARD AS FOLLOWS:
A Local Law Repealing Local Law # 2 of 1991 Concerning Tax Exemptions for
Qualified Solar & Wind Energy Structures in the Town of Whitehall**

BE IT ENACTED, by the Town Board of the TOWN OF WHITEHALL, in the County of Washington, State of New York as follows:

Section 1. Purpose.

The Town Board desires the ability to grant real property tax exemptions for qualified solar and wind structures located in the Town pursuant to Real Property Tax Law Section 487.

Section 2. Repeal Local Law # 2 of 1991 of the Town of Whitehall

Local Law # 2 of 1991 of the Town of Whitehall is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Local Law shall take effect immediately after filing with the Secretary of State of the State of New York.
