Pledge of Allegiance

Mayor opened discussion to:

- Larry Drown requested Steve Brock DPW two months ago and is requesting help from the board to turn on the water at his property on William Street to indicate where the water location/leak, and where the problem is. This will indicate whom is responsible for the digging. Mayor Putorti responded that the village will work on it with no guarantee. Larry indicated that he will not dig in the road. Mayor Putorti will get back to Larry.
- Troy Rollins, owner of Freaktropolis, requested information regarding the destroyed buildings in the Village. Mayor Putorti stated we are working on it, we are working on grant money. It is an issue that needs to be taken care of.
- Troy Rollins also asked about William Street being paved, Trustee Watson indicated it will be done this year.
- John Burgart is addressed the motor home's sewer across from his house is hooked up to the Village sewer. Mayor indicated that the ownership of the property has changed last week, and our Zoning Officer has filed a Notice of Violation. Robin Burgart indicated that the owner stated that if walking on the sidewalk is trespassing. Mayor Putorti stated the sidewalk is the Village's property.
- Joe Egan indicated there are motorized bikes in the Village are dangerous and could hurt someone. Mayor Putorti stated that if all goes well the Washington County Sheriff will be on board and be handled.
- John Burgart mentioned sidewalks near him home are difficult for a wheelchair. Mayor Putorti stated we are shorthanded.
- John Burgart asked if he could repair the sidewalk. Mayor Putorti will look into it. Trustee Watson indicated he made a note of the sidewalk and will look into it.
- Kristen Miner, President of Skene Manor, asked if a Banner about the history of Skene Manor if it was a good idea to be posted on the fence behind the Laundromat. Mayor Putorti indicated he thought it was a good idea. She also asked if the antenna by Skene Manor is still needed because Police Department is dissolved. Mayor Putorti indicated he's not sure as of yet, but we will find out.

Motion to approve Washington County Sheriff Contract made by Trustee Norton, seconded by Trustee Putorti, all in favor **CARRIED**

Proposals for electrical services for Water Treatment Plant from CR-12, Hour Electric Co, Inc. and Johnson Electrical for electrical services.

Motion made by Trustee Norton to approve CR-12 proposal for electrical services for the Water Treatment Plant, seconded by Trustee LaChapelle, all in favor **CARRIED**

LETTERS:

Letter from President Brian Brooks requested the Village to pay the current Surveyors invoice of \$3400 for surveying the land under the fire house. Tabled until further discussions with Brian Brooks, all in favor. **CARRIED**

Letter from Beth Reynolds requesting relief on your water and sewer bill due to a leaking hot water tank, which has been repaired. The letter indicated that water did not go through the sewer system. Mayor Putorti stated in the past practice the resident has been responsible for all of the water charges and half of the cost of sewer.

Letter from National Grid regarding 20% increase, and a Letter from Environmental Facilities Corporation regarding Clean Water State Revolving Fund

Motion made by Trustee Watson to accept all correspondence, seconded by Trustee LaChapelle, all in favor, **CARRIED**

Motion made by Trustee Norton to accept abstract, seconded by Trustee Watson, all in favor, **CARRIED**

Trustee Norton reports that repairs were made for the solarbee in water tower at Skene Manor, repairs issues with the distribution pump and injectors

Trustee LaChapelle stated Dickie LaChapelle has the list of items for the Police Department. Requested identification for Zoning/Compliance officer.

Trustee Watson reported DPW has been doing a little black-topping, and managing water leaks. WWTP - DEC did inspection, doing inspections for ultra-violet, Repairing pump stations, need updated panel boxes and requested price quotes to update the panel boxes.

Motion made by Trustee Norton to accept Applications, seconded by Trustee Putorti, all in favor,

Motion made by Trustee Norton to file Reports, seconded by Trustee Putorti, all in favor,

Committee was created to review the Engineering Proposals for Sub catchment 3, Pump Station 3, which will include Trustee Norton and Trustee Watson.

Mayor comments: Presbyterian Church destruction of property, Sinkhole on South Williams St due to the storm, and burn complaint from resident. No burn-ban in place.

Brian Brooks, arrived late, indicated he submitted a letter requesting the Village to pay Invoice for the surveyor of the land below the firehouse.

Motion to pay \$1700, half of the surveyor cost made by Trustee LaChapelle, seconded by Trustee Watson, all in favor. **CARRIED**

Brian Brooks also requested that the remainder \$1700 be taken from the fire house budget, draw-down.

Brian Brooks reported he applied for a grant to build a live fire training, requesting a small section of parking lot to build a cover for the trailers, Mayor indicated he will Table until further information is given.

Brian Brooks, also indicated he submitted Letters to the Board regarding the Police Department vehicles, and requested one vehicle for firehouse use. Mayor Putorti indication the Village will hold onto the vehicles.

Brian Brooks submitted a letter to the Board regarding the establishment of a joint fire district.

Motion made by Trustee LaChapelle to adjourn the meeting 7:16pm, seconded by Trustee Putorti, all in favor, **CARRIED**
